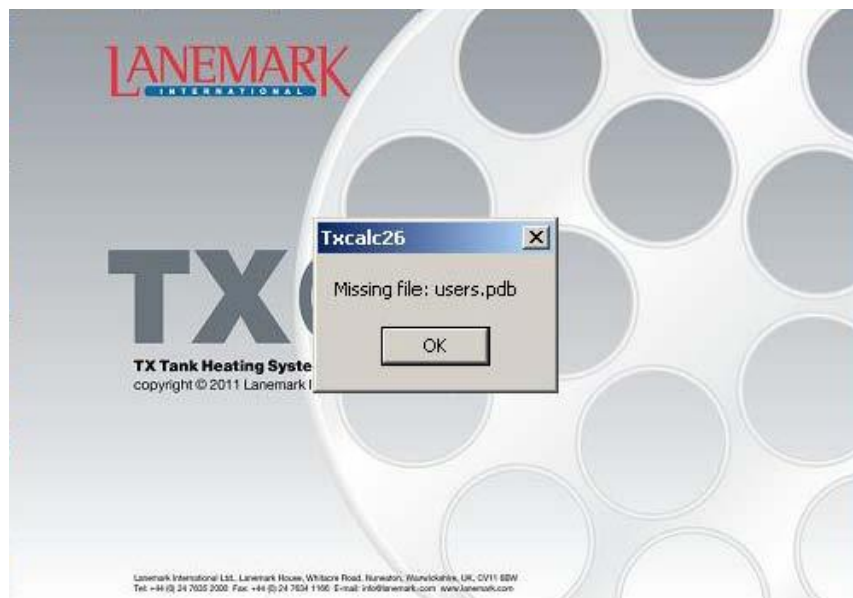




## CREATING TxCalc VERSION 5 NEW USER INSTALLATION

### PART 1

- Step 1:** Copy the file ***"TxCalcV5.zip"*** file to the required directory on your computer.
- Step 2:** Extract the contents of the zip file to a new directory from which you wish to run the ***"TxCalcV5.exe"*** program
- Step 3:** Run the program ***"TxCalcV5.exe"***, which will initially display the window below. ***Select "OK"***



The next window will show the TxCalc **'Key Code'** as below - each computer will generate a unique **"Key Code"**.



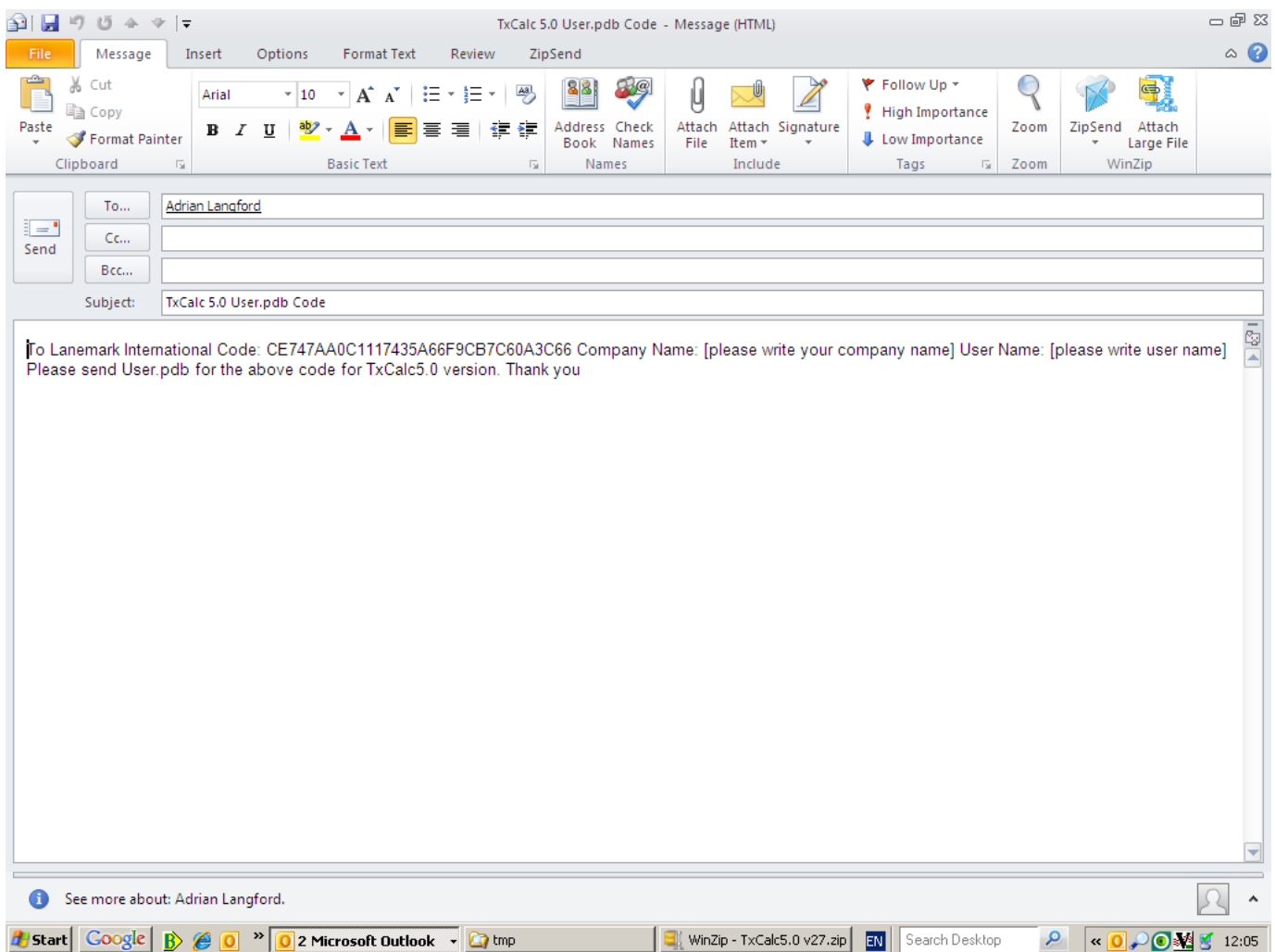
**Step 4:** Either Click “Copy & Email” or “Copy & Close”

**A. “Copy & Email”**

This option will open your E-mail program

## CREATING TxCalc VERSION 5 NEW USER INSTALLATION

### PART 2

When a request for a new user registration file is received by Lanemark (UK), a file called “users.pdb will be created which will include your “User Name” and “Password”

**Step 5:** Copy the ‘*Users.pdb*’ file to the folder where the “TxCalcV5.exe” file is located

**Step 6:** Run the program ‘*TxCalcV5.exe*’ and an “Authentication” login screen requesting a User Name and Password will appear.

Enter the “User Name” and “Password” provided by Lanemark



*If the ‘Use auto inputs’, is selected TxCalcV5 will not ask for a Username and Password each time the program is run.*

**Step 7:** Select **OK** to enter the program.
